Who should enrol on this course?

You will also be prepared to be sensitive to issues of race, gender, age and sexual orientation, as well as to have respect for the human body. This qualification will also equip you with the necessary tools to communicate interpersonally across a wide spectrum. It provides training for both first-time job seekers and for experienced employees who do not have a qualification, but who wish to advance in their careers

What are the pre-requisites for the course?

Ed-U City Campus has an open, transparent and democratic admissions policy. Its aim is to provide opportunities to individuals to upgrade, develop and acquire qualifications to foster greater employability.

In order for you to enrol on this course you should be in possession of:

- Original or certified copies of a National Senior Certificate (Level 4 on the National Qualifications Framework) or an N3 Certificate or equivalent. ('Equivalent' refers to foreign qualifications (these are qualifications that you obtained in a foreign country, and which are evaluated by SAQA to be equivalent to the university entrance qualification of South Africa).
- Subjects passed must be of an Academic or Commercial nature

- A good command of English. Basic literacy skills such as reading and writing, and to communicate effectively in written form. The ability to analyse, interpret and critically evaluate written and verbal information.
- Numeracy skills at NQF Level 4. Fundamental numeracy, communication, literacy and life skills.

Duration of the course

The course is delivered in the following manner:

- You attend full-time classes at our campus in Port Elizabeth over a period of two years.
- Each year is divided into two semesters.
- You will have access to a computer lab for research purposes
